Minutes of Community Relations, Recreation & Health Committee Meeting

 - Administrator McKee shared that under the general permit we have, it would have allowed for 1300 more cubic yards of dredging.

 - Discussion of the purpose of the pond - is it aesthetics or fishing? That purpose needs to be considered in the decision as to what is done and the cost to the taxpayers.
 - Mattoon will talk to Michelle Skinner to see if we can mechanically modify the sediment trap we have to make it more efficient and will report back to the committee.
